What services does The Grove provide?

The Grove Counseling Center provides therapy to children, adults, and families who are either experiencing mental health or substance abuse issues or who are at risk to get such issues. We are committed to empower the individual at all levels through individualized support plans.

What ages does The Grove provide services for?

The Grove is able to serve individuals of all ages. Outpatient services are available for adolescents and adults. The Academy serves youth 13 to 17 years of ages. Wraparound works with children from 5 years old to 21.

How do individuals pay for services?

The Grove is in network with 27 insurance providers. For those who do not have insurance, we adjust our fees using a sliding scale based on income for those who qualify. The Academy can cost a family as low as \$2 a day. We also accept traditional Medicaid in Outpatient.

What should a family expect when first contacting The Grove for mental health or substance abuse services?

The Grove has drug screening capabilities if there is a suspicion of drug abuse (\$25 for in-house testing). An initial assessment is done at our outpatient offices to determine what the best support plan is for the individual. A recommendation can range from weekly therapy sessions to residential treatment.

Does The Grove provide any case management services?

Wraparound Seminole is a resource for families raising a child with a mental health diagnosis and is considered a hybrid form of case management. This process involves working with the family and a support team to create a plan to address all the needs of the family and child.
